Also

$$\int_0^\infty e^{-x^2} dx = \frac{\sqrt{\pi}}{2}$$

Yes, but is this really working correctly? How about pictures?

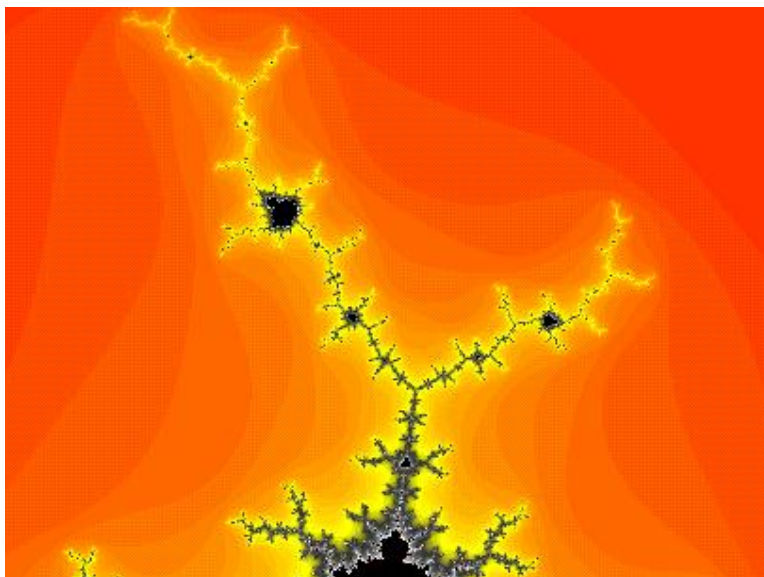


Figure 1: A Simple Graphic
